

Information about what to do during a local incident, Fire, Flood or Storm.

What to Expect	<h3>Assembly Area</h3> <h3>Elma Fagan Community Centre</h3> <p>Listen to public announcements as the assembly area may change.</p>	When to Go
<p>Limited visibility during fires or storms</p> <p>Limited or restricted access to Waratah</p> <p>Loss of communications as local ABC radio may be off air for periods of time</p> <p>Loss of power and telephone communications so remember cordless telephones rely on power</p> <p>Town water supply may fail so do not rely on town water for fire fighting purposes</p>		<p>When you hear that an incident is impacting or will impact on the Waratah area</p> <p>Go Early</p> <p>when advised by Tasmanian Fire Service, SES, Tasmania Police or local radio.</p> <p>When leaving your home, close all windows and doors, close curtains, drapes, blinds, turn off lights, gas bottles and air conditioning.</p>

What to Wear		
<p>Fire Natural fibre (wool or cotton), long sleeve top and long pants, solid footwear (leather), wide brimmed hat, smoke mask and a towel</p> <p>Flood Solid footwear (leather)</p>		
What to Take		Monitor Local Radio
<p>Medications for 7 days / toiletries for at least 3 days</p> <p>Prescriptions</p> <p>Clothing (summer/winter), photos, personal items, woollen blanket, food and drinking water</p> <p>Documents - passports, titles, bank accounts, birth, marriage and insurance certificates</p> <p>Mobile phone, charger, portable radio, torch and batteries</p> <p>Pet food, leads, cages and bowls</p>	<p>Waratah-Wynyard Council Wynyard 6443 8333</p> <p>Waratah 6439 7100</p>	<p>Waratah ABC</p> <p>ABC 104.1</p>
