FOOD / DRINK Children are required to bring morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea for the day unless indicated by a cooking experience e.g. cooking lunch etc. Please send a drink bottle with your child.

HATS / SHOES all children must have a hat daily for outdoors.
If your child doesn't have a hat, we'll provide one and a fee of \$12 will be charged to your account.
It is essential your child wears socks and runners/sandshoes on all excursion days. This helps keep them comfortable and safe during activities. *No Crocs, open-toe sandals or thongs, please.*

CLOTHING dress in sensible clothing (no singlet tops/dresses or very short shorts as these do not meet sun safe practices). A change of clothes is also advised if messy activities.
Please ensure all belongings are clearly labelled.

SUNSCREEN from September – end April, send own if unable to use service supplied sunscreen.

EXCURSIONS may change due to weather. Please ensure to arrive at program 10-15 minutes prior to departure times.
