STATEMENT AND DECLARATION

I Operating as a commercial water carrier declare that I will conduct business as a commercial water carrier in a manner consistent with the Public Health Act 1997, and the associated Drinking Water Guidelines, in particular Appendix B.

I agree to abide by the following:

- **That the tanks and associated equipment will not be used for any other purpose than to transport water for human consumption;**
- All pipes, fittings and materials used in contact with water will be suitable plumbing or food grade products suitable for use with drinking water - (Australian Standard 4020 details the standard of materials);
- In normal operation only potable water from an approved Council supply will be used;
- In the case of an emergency or other extraordinary event requiring the supply of water from a non potable source (untreated) – warnings will be provided to the consumer in accordance with Appendix B of the guidelines (advising to boil or disinfect water before consumption, and advising of the source), and to clean and disinfect the water tank in accordance with the Drinking Water Quality Guidelines prior to resuming cartage of potable water;
- That the tank and equipment will be maintained in a state of good repair, kept in a clean condition and operated in a manner that ensures the hygienic transportation of drinking water;
- That the water tank, pipes and fittings will be cleaned and in accordance with the requirements Appendix B (monthly cleaning of pipes and fittings, water tanks at a minimum of 3 months);
- A log book will be kept, detailing all delivery and cleaning details as required by Appendix B of the guidelines.
