

Summer Restrictions for Dogs on Beaches

1 December until 28 February

The following areas have been declared as restricted, prohibited or exercise areas under the Dog Control Act 2000. These areas are signposted for easy reference, as follows:

Restricted	Dogs must be on a leash at all times. During Summer: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Restricted before 10:00am and after 6:00pm • Prohibited between 10:00am and 6:00pm
Prohibited	No dogs allowed at any time
Exercise	Dogs allowed to be taken at any time. Dogs may be exercised off leash, under effective control.

Restricted Beaches Include:

- Boat Harbour: From the western end of beach to the last house on beach
- Sisters Beach: From Stockdale Avenue to Honeysuckle Avenue
- Wynyard: From Fossil Bluff and the Inglis River mouth to the Port Creek mouth
- Somerset: From Arthur Street to Cam River

Prohibited Beaches Include:

- Somerset: From the Seabrook Creek mouth to Woody Point

Exercise Beaches Include:

- Sisters Beach: From Stockdale Avenue to the Boat Ramp
- Wynyard: From the Port Creek mouth to Seabrook Creek mouth
- Somerset: From Arthur Street to Woody Point



General Information

Dog owners are advised to take a plastic bag with them when out walking to clean up any faeces left by their dog. Dogs must be under effective control whenever in a public place.

It is illegal to take a dog or allow a dog to roam into a National Park. The Sisters Beach community is set amongst the beautiful Rocky Cape National Park, so please take care of our native wildlife by ensuring your dog or cat is secured on your property.

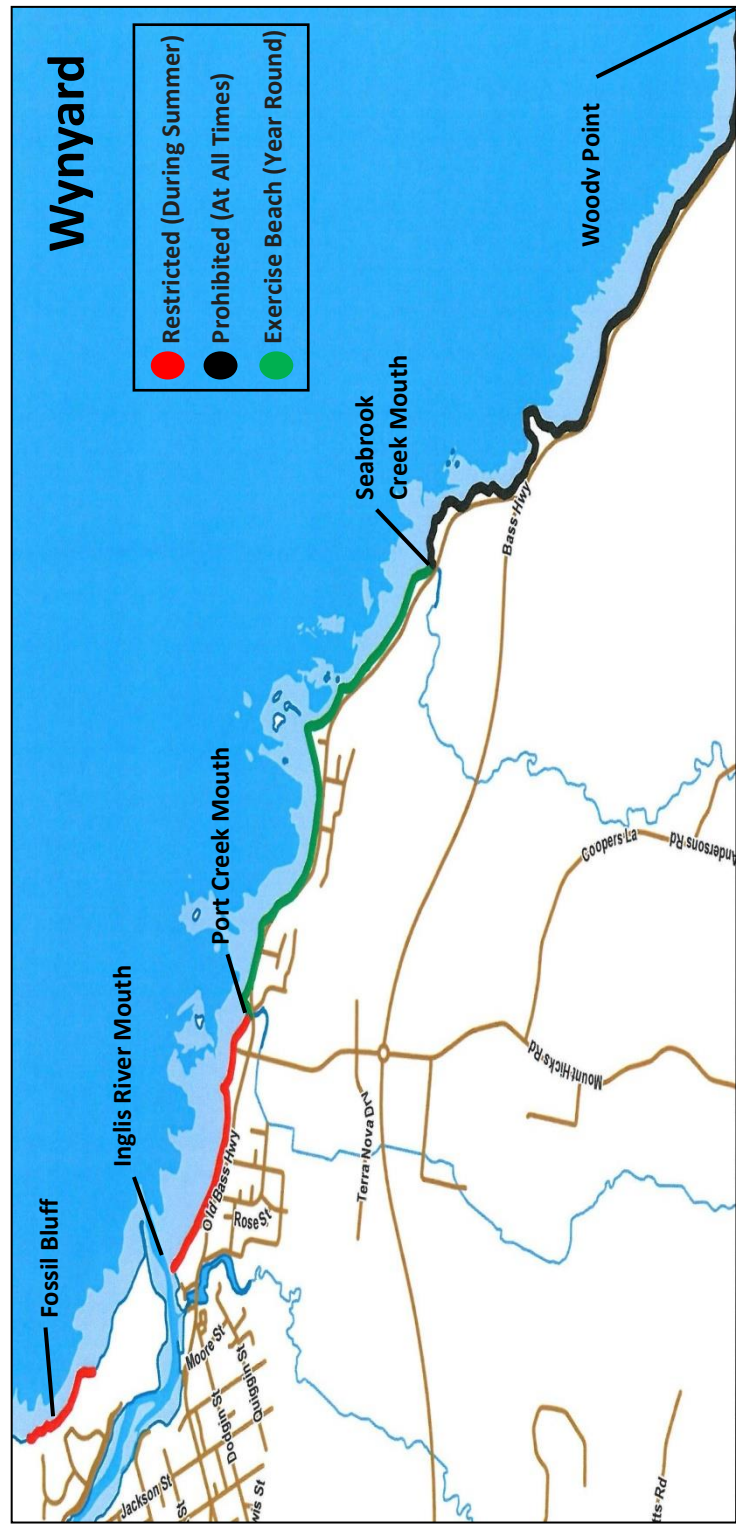

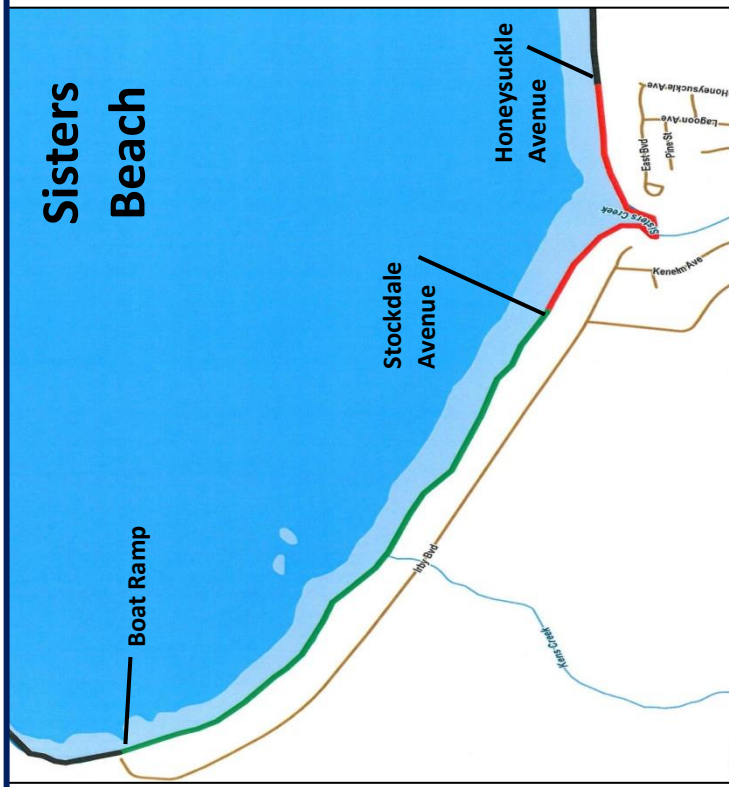

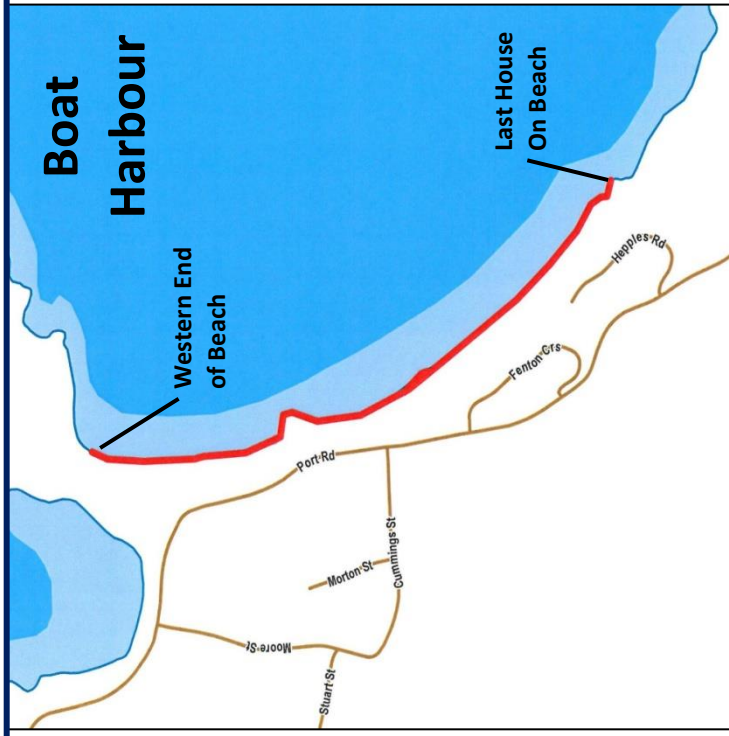
