Council welcomes Wynyard Woolworths revamp

Waratah-Wynyard Council welcomes the investment from supermarket giant Woolworths via the upgrades to the Wynyard Woolworths store and car park.

Mayor Walsh said the project was positive news for local shoppers, but more significantly demonstrated a long-term commitment by a multi-national company to the future growth of the area.

“Wynyard is a town that is on the move,” Mayor Walsh said. “And the Woolworths’ upgrade is a welcome investment alongside the many projects Council is undertaking to improve and further beautify our town.”

The resealed and upgraded car park was the final part of the project and will complement the \$4.5million revamp to the Wynyard Woolworths store.

New line markings were made - with the car parking configuration running in an east-west direction, as opposed to north-south - and trolley bays have been installed.

While Council owns the land, the work is part of an agreement with Woolworths to upgrade the whole area.

Woolworths will hold an official relaunch party in the supermarket on Friday, November 15 at 8am.
