Council invites written representations for new draft Tasmanian Planning Scheme

In line with the Tasmanian Government's strategy for a statewide planning scheme, the Waratah-Wynyard Council has released a Draft Local Provisions Schedule that is now open for public comment.

The Tasmanian Planning Scheme will apply across the whole State and will replace the existing Interim Planning Scheme, however it will include both State Planning Provisions and Local Planning Provisions for each Council area.

"Whilst the Tasmanian Planning Scheme aims to provide consistency in legislation across the State, the Local Provisions Schedule addresses how it will apply specifically to land within the Waratah-Wynyard Council municipal boundary" said Mayor Walsh.

The Draft Local Provisions Schedule contains the zone maps, overlay maps and local area objectives.

Representations must be made in writing to the Waratah-Wynyard Council by post, email or in person by 24 May 2022.
